



CPN Conduct

Collaroy Plateau Netball **Members / Players**

- **Code of Behaviour:** All members must abide by the [Netball NSW Code of Behaviour Policy](#).
- **Registration Fees and Memberships:** Members agree to pay registration fees as outlined by Collaroy Plateau Netball Club (CPNC) prior to CPNC accepting any registration. Applications for membership are subject to a position being available in a team.
- **Season Commitment:** Once registered, players are committed to the full season. Refunds are only given to players for medical reasons.
- **Grading Policy:** CPNC will conduct grading of all players. Acceptance of our Grading Policy is necessary when applying for registration. Please refer to our Grading Policy. Team placements are final once teams are selected.
- **Attendance & Punctuality:** Players are expected to attend all training sessions and games as directed by their Coach and to inform them of their unavailability for a competition match at least two days prior so that substitutes can be identified as necessary.
- **Uniform:** Players are to take the court wearing full CPNC netball uniform for all competition matches.
- **Sportsmanship:** Players are to display good sportsmanship at all times.
- **Respect for Coaches:** Players are to respect their Coaches who generously volunteer their time. This includes not questioning a Coach's decision regarding a player's position or match time. Coaches are to ensure even court time for all players during the regular season and at least one quarter of play in final games.
- **Respect for Umpires:** Players are to respect the Umpires at all times. Without umpires, there are no games. If there are any issues with games or umpiring, please go to the control tower for assistance during the game. After the game, it will be too late.
- **MWNA Bylaws:** Players are to abide by the Manly Warringah Netball Association (MWNA) Bylaws.
- **Club Duties:** All players (12 years and over) are expected to complete umpiring duties when requested. Teams will be allocated and are required to rotate all players to perform these duties.

Parents & Caregivers

- **Positive Club Culture:** CPNC is committed to fostering a safe, encouraging, and positive community environment. Sideline hostility, public complaining, spreading negativity, or engaging in gossip—whether in person, in group chats, or on social media—undermines our club culture and will not be tolerated.
- **Respect for Volunteers & Committee:** CPNC is entirely run by volunteers, including our coaches, managers, and committee members, who dedicate countless unpaid hours so children can play netball. Parents must treat all volunteers with respect. Public criticism or harassment of volunteers will not be tolerated.
- **Constructive Engagement & Choice of Club:** If you wish to contribute constructively to how the club operates, we encourage you to volunteer for a committee or match-day role. We recognize that our club environment, policies, or management style may not suit every family; if a parent or caregiver feels CPNC no longer aligns with their expectations, they are welcome to seek another club that better suits their needs.
- **Respect for Coaches' Decisions:** Parents are to respect Coaches' decisions regarding player positions and match-time allocations.
- **Respect for Umpires:** Parents must respect all Umpires at all times. Players need to learn to adapt to different officiating styles without sideline interference. Parents are not to engage or critique umpires.
- **Support for Grading:** Parents are to support and encourage children in the grade assigned to them, ensuring they play alongside peers of similar skill levels.
- **Child Safety:** Parents acting in official team roles or coaching must complete a valid Working With Children Check (WWCC).
